Her inspiration originated when her 86 year-old mother was in ICU for 4 days and her attending physician entered her room twice only, made some notes in the patient chart, and exited the room without ever offering a compassionate word or a healing touch. She was also disappointed with the overall "lack of feeling cared for" by the staff at many medical offices. Gina was determined to bring medical etiquette back to healthcare.

The Passion for Patients™ Coaching Program is designed to increase patient satisfaction and engagement, galvanize staff loyalty and empower the team, and improve reimbursements in healthcare organizations. This mission-based work was inspired by the simple question: how can we bring Medical Etiquette back to healthcare? Organizations that have completed the Passion for Patients™ Workshops report improved patient satisfaction scores, fewer patient complaints, more collaborative and communicative teams, and a more congenial work environment.

In December 2017, Passion for Patients™ provided their customized and interactive workshops to the staff at Health City on Grand Cayman to provide interpersonal and intercultural training for staff.
